Important Dates:

Time to buy Tests:

- **Feb. 27 – March 17** at the attendance window.
- Before School, During Break, or at lunch.
- To purchase Exam please have ready:
 - Completed form (will be available Feb.22nd)
 - Student ID
 - Check or money order with student's name and "short" ID number in memo line
- Or online through out webstore at www.irvinehigh.org
- ***Last day to purchase a test is March 17th at noon – no exceptions
- No refunds will be given

Mandatory Pre-Administration Day

This is when you will fill out all necessary paperwork to get your testing ID number

- **Wed. April 26** (Last Names A – K)
 - 1:00pm (minimum day)
- **Thurs. April 27** (Last Names L-Z)
 - 1:00 pm (minimum day)
- This is **Mandatory** for all students

Day of Testing: What do I need?

Mandatory

- **Student Pack** (Given at Pre-Administration Day)
- **Current Student ID Card.** (If you lost yours, purchase a new one in the downstairs office for \$5)
- **Two or more No. 2 Pencil** (No Mechanical)
- **Blue or Black Pen**
- **Approved Calculator (check with AP Teacher if you are allowed one)** EX: Spanish, Music Theory, etc....will not need a calculator

Optional

- Clear plastic bag to hold mandatory items.
- **Snack/ Drink in clear bag for break** (Please put your name on bag) You may only access your snack or drink during break time. These are not allowed in testing area.
- **Approved Calculator for some science and Math tests – check with your AP Teacher**
- **Tissue**
- **Extra Erasers (No casing around them)**

Items not allowed on testing day

- Any Electronic equipment
 - Cell Phones, laptop, smart watch, camera, portable listening devices, any device that access the internet.
- Any type of book
- Notes, highlighter, or colored pencils, mechanical pencils
- Clothing with subject related material
- Compasses or protractors
- Correction fluid/ tape
- Scratch paper
- Watches of any type
