

Advanced Placement Exams

Registration/Sales for the Advanced Placement exams will be

- **February 26 – March 4** for Irvine HS Students only (online and in person).
- **March 5 – March 16** for all Students (non- I.H.S. students must email or call Mrs. Kamai before purchasing any test for pre-approval)

Exams will be sold before school, break and lunch for \$105 per exam for IHS students at the cashier's window and online at our [Webstore](#) (additional service fee applies). Non IUSD students are \$150 per exam and can be purchased at the Irvine High School Cashier's Window only. Students should complete a registration form prior to the purchase of exams. Registration forms are available in the upstairs office and from AP Teachers.

**Note AP Chinese Test: The cost for AP Chinese tests are \$170 and sold online only at our [Webstore](#) to the first 64 Irvine HS students from 2/26 – 3/04.

All Non- Irvine HS Students can purchase AP Chinese tests on site on March 6th with waiver from Mrs. Kamai in the upstairs office of the Student Center. After the initial 64 have been purchased, we may open up an additional day if there is enough interest. Please see Mrs. Kamai in the upstairs office for a waiver to take the test.
