STUDENT ACTIVITIES BEHAVIORAL COMMITMENT

Care and concern for the safety/welfare of Irvine High School students has prompted the development of this agreement. All students attending an Irvine High School activity, on or off campus, are expected to know that appropriate behavior is required and that all school rules are enforced at any activity sponsored or supported by Irvine High School. Activities include, but are not limited to dances, athletic events, senior activities, banquets, pep rallies, performing arts events, camp, field trips, lunch activities, etc. All students and parents, please be aware of the following specifics regarding school activities:

- To gain admittance to an event, each student must have an **Irvine High School ID Card**. If the student does not have an ID card, he/she must get a duplicate (at a \$5.00 fee) from the Activities Office prior to the event.
- Once a student leaves an event, he/she may not return. No student will be admitted to an event after 10:00 PM.
- > Bids/tickets are not transferable from student to student and there are no refunds after a ticket is purchased.
- Students will be warned of any inappropriate behavior (i.e. inappropriate dancing) and if student does not comply with the request, they will be asked to call their parents and leave the dance, no refund will be given. Please see attached Dance Code.
- Any student found to be "under the influence" or in possession of alcohol or any other controlled substance at a school activity will be removed and parents will be notified. Student will then be suspended for five school days and excluded from all school activities for an additional ten school days. An additional three days of substance-abuse counseling is mandatory. Parent participation is required.
- A student may be charged with possession, if alcohol or any other controlled substance is found in a vehicle in which the student is a passenger, even if the substance is in a sealed container.
- For a second offense, the student will be removed from Irvine High School.
- When dances allow for guests, each non-Irvine student must fill out a guest pass form. This form must be turned in to the Activities Office when tickets are purchased (All guests are required to show a photo ID at the door and must be <u>under</u> the age of 21). All Irvine students sponsoring a guest are responsible for the behavior of their guest. See attached Guest Policy.

BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, the student acknowledges awareness of these conditions and accepts the responsibility to attend any and all school activities free from the influence of any controlled substance.

"I understand all school events are drug, alcohol, and tobacco free. I, along with any guest I may bring, agree to remain drug, alcohol, and tobacco free at all school events. Furthermore, I have read and understand the above rules pertaining to student conduct at school events and I understand the consequences for any inappropriate behavior. I have also read and will comply with the dress code for dances.

THIS CONTRACT MUST BE ON FILE TO ATTEND ANY IRVINE HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITY. STUDENTS WHO HAVE NOT PLACED THIS CONTRACT ON FILE (SIGNED BY BOTH STUDENT & PARENT) WILL NOT BE SOLD ADMISSION TICKETS TO IRVINE HIGH EVENTS.
